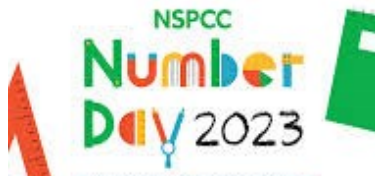

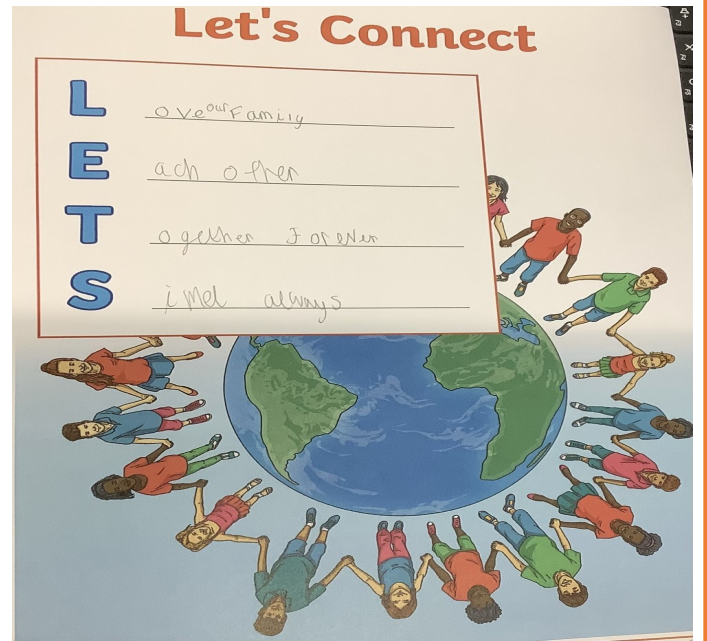

If you, friends or family, could offer a placement for one of our Year 11 we would be interested in hearing from you. We will then visit to discuss and hopefully match with a suitable student.

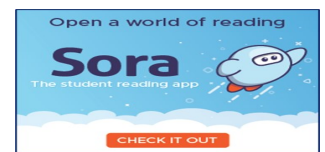
Another, equally important, way of helping out would be to offer vocational visits or online experiences to our students. Again we would love to hear from you.
