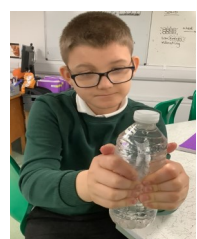
Macbeth Workshop

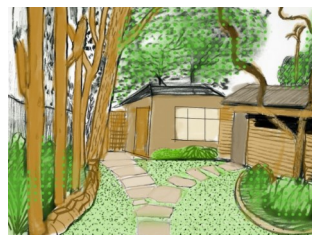
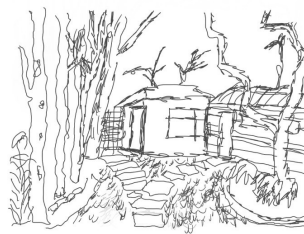
Cartesian (pressure) divers

This week in science students have investigated pressure and its effects. They made a Cartesian Diver. These work by pressing on the bottle. The pressure goes through the liquid, this causes water to be forced into the diver. The diver gets heavier and sinks. By changing the pressure on the bottle the driver can be controlled up and down.
