## Wonderful Writing Skills

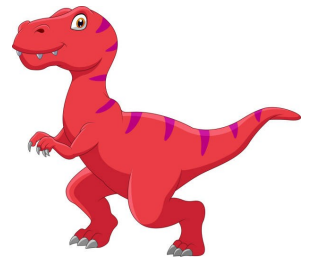
Jenson a member of our Coppice family has written a fantastic children's story which is so good we had to share.
