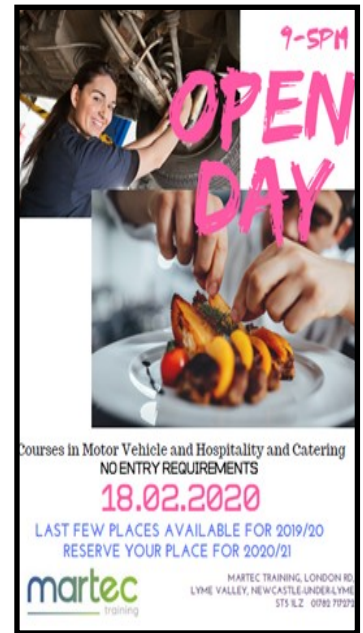

FareShare have teamed up with some of the biggest retail supermarkets in the U.K to redistribute their end of day surplus food for free!

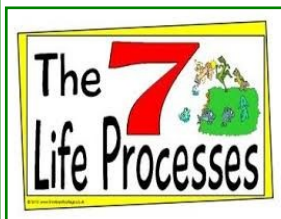

We are really pleased to announce that The Coppice have successfully been accepted by FareShare to become one of their partners. The Coppice is now collecting free end of day surplus food from our local supermarket and by doing this we are helping ensure good edible food is used and not discarded. We collected our first donation this week which included croissants and bread which has enabled us to provide an alternative option at breakfast and break times.

CURRICULUM SUBJECT FOCUS: SCIENCE

It has been a very exciting term in the Science Department.

Y7 have been looking at Life processes and adaptations.



Students have been discovering the interactions of living things within their environment from ecosystems through to adaptations. Students have explored the processes that indicate life and have correctly deduced that Alfie is alive!

Y8/9 have been exploring the particulate nature of matter, the difference in arrangements of particles in solids, liquids and gases based on the particle model. Further to this, students have been shown how matter can change from one state to another and the movement of particles in terms of diffusion. Students have been conducting experiments using skittles to understand the process of diffusion.



KS4 have been looking into causes of diseases and maintaining health. Students are developing an understanding of the most significant factors affecting health and an awareness of the



causes of particular diseases. Students have been reading about the recent outbreak in China and thinking about how to contain a virus.

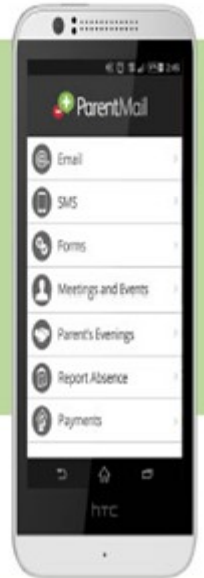
