Teaching & Whole School Strategies (£7,500)

- Supporting great online teaching
- Ongoing high quality CPD
- Additional support for early careers teachers Pupil assessment & feedback
- Time to enable teachers to assess pupils' wellbeing and learning internally and externally (home visits)
- Subject-specific assessments used to identify areas where pupils have forgotten or misunderstood key concepts
- Standardised assessments in literacy / numeracy used to identify pupils who would benefit from additional intervention sessions.
- Teams and website materials shared with y6 pupils
- Transition visits in July to support y6 pupils.
- Additional maths software to support GCSE students

Targeted Support (£10.000)

- Boxall profile support resources
- One to one clinical psychologist sessions
- Small intervention group
- Focus on disadvantaged pupils from all year groups.
- SEMH pastoral support – delivered by trained staff

Wider Strategies (£6.000)

- Supporting parents and carers
- Printing costs
- Regular and supportive communications with parents, especially to increase attendance and engagement with learning.
- Providing educational resources to families during isolation
- Access to technology
- Resources provided and catch up work set over the summer
